How to Collect Donations

Cash Donations

We understand that some school events work best with in-person donations. That's absolutely fine — here's how to do it:

- Assign a named staff member to securely collect and count donations with a second staff member present (for transparency)
- Use our tamper-proof collection box and/or envelopes.

Once counted and logged, schools can either:

- Transfer the total via bank payment to the charity account (we'll provide details)
- OR request a secure pick-up/drop-off arrangement for local schools

We'll issue a formal receipt and confirmation for all received donations.
